





3-1. Setting Method

The following settings can be changed easily on the panel stored inside of front cover even after installation.




- Adjustment of Sound Volume
Adjustment of sound volume is possible by means of the volume (knob).
- Combination Method of the Tones
In the case of the group H, tones can be freely combined among 32 tones, by utilizing a SD card.
- Selection Switch
Selection of the following functions is possible.
"Selection of the tone group," "Test playing" and "Switching of the input mode."




Selection of the Tone Group※1



Test Playing




Switching of Bit/Binary Input

3-3. Input Timing Chart



※1 Each group has 8 tones, from CH1 to CH8. Refer to "3-6. List of the tones."

※2 Tones can be freely combined with a SD card (sold separately) and transferred to group H. Refer to "3-6. List of the tones."

※3 In case of test play mode, the sound stored in CH1 is always played back.

※4 Refer to "List of the tones" about the sound played back. (Refer the CH number when bit input, and refer the tone number when binary input.)

※5 In case the input is changed within 300ms before the playback, it would take another 300ms or less to activate the sound again.

3-4. Binary Code Table

To select the binary input mode, set the DIP switch number 6 to ON.

In the binary input mode, the corresponding CH as shown in the below table is played back by short-circuiting the CH lines and common line.

In case the input which is not shown in the table is made, "5. Rapid Hi-Lo" is played back.



3-7. Rewriting Method of Group H

Tones can be freely combined with a SD card (sold separately) and transferred to group H. In case of rewriting the sound combination, follow the following procedures.

1. Prepare a SD card, and store the following data in it.
The file name must be one byte alphabetical characters. (Case insensitive)
The tone numbers in the text file must be designated by one byte numbers.







2. Make sure that the power is supplied to the product.
3. The data transfer is started automatically by inserting the SD card into the card slot.
4. When the data transfer is finished, the informing sound (continuous beep sound) is played. Then, take out the SD card from the product.
If the informing sound or no beep is played, the data transfer is not completed successfully. The informing sound cannot be heard if the sound level is set to minimum.
5. Select the tone group to H, and confirm if the tone of each CH is stored as designated.

Timing Chart



- * Do not take out the SD card until the informing sound is played when transferring the data.
- * Once the data transfer starts, the sound is not played back until the informing sound is played even if the signal is input to the product.
- * If the SD card is inserted while playing a tone, data transfer is started after the playback is finished.
